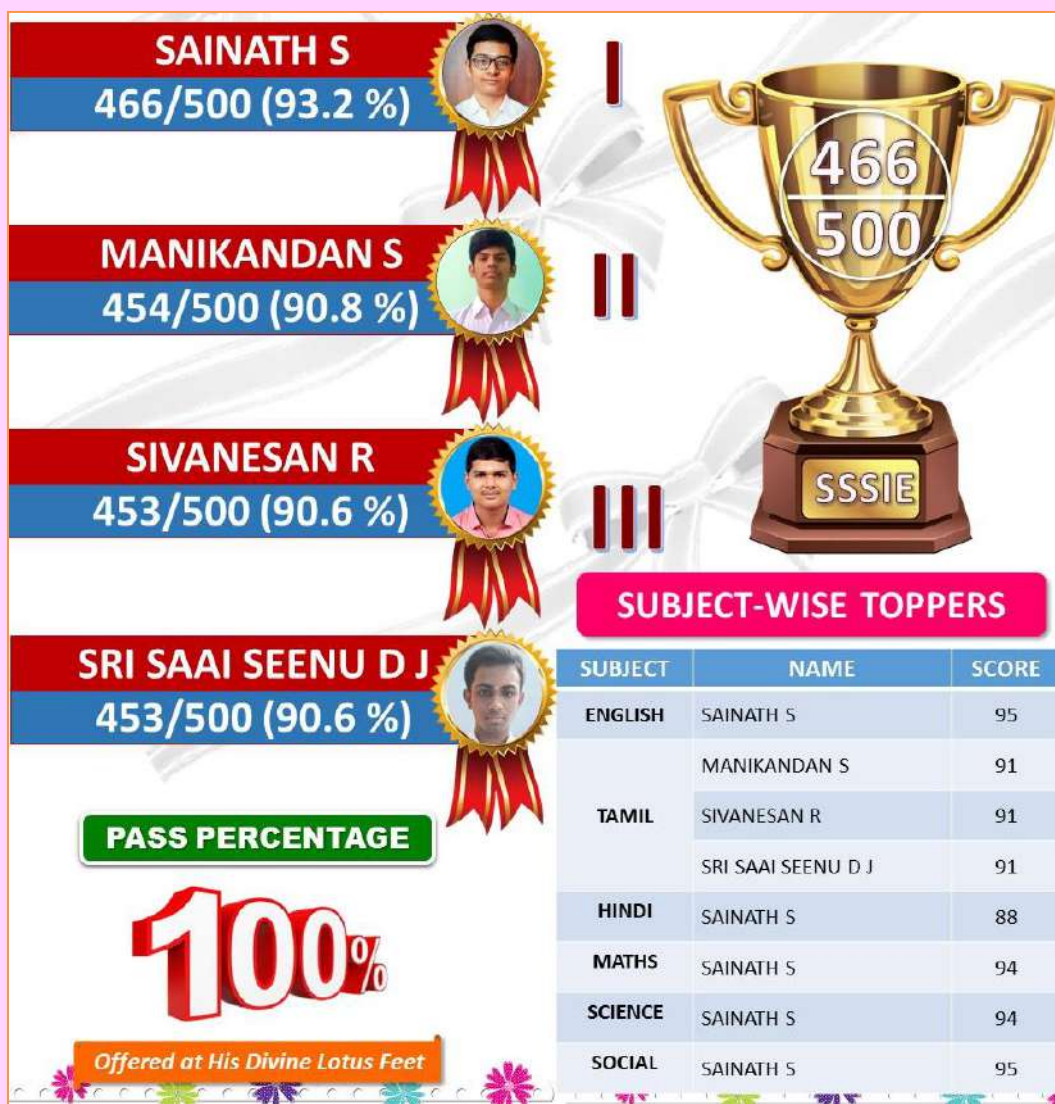

EXTRAMARKS – ONLINE CLASSES

In the wake of the Lockdown due to COVID-19, as per Government instructions, SSSIE began the online classes for all the students, in a phased manner, from Senior Secondary to KG classes gradually. For classes from IV to XII, '**Extramarks**' (an online classes application with facilities for efficient live classes management and vast content mapped to CBSE syllabus for all the classes) was used. For KG and classes from I to III recorded video clips were used to transact the lessons to children' home.

The online classes were managed in an exemplary manner with systematic reports maintained for Teachers' Time Table, Observer Report, Weekly Planner, Case Study for each student etc.



PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS

- Being a pioneer school in online education, various technological tools were used to assess students both online and offline.
- MCQ form of tests were conducted through Extramarks platform every month in all subjects.
- Students attended subjective form of tests for Unit Tests/Quarterly/Half-yearly and Annual Exams, sitting at home, with online invigilation by the teachers.
- Results were sent to the parents immediately and PTMs were organized to inform the students of their academic growth.

KRISHNASHTAMI

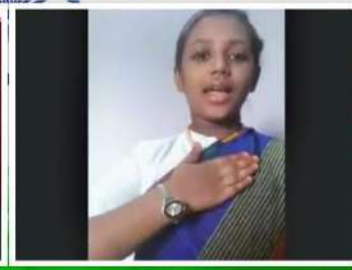
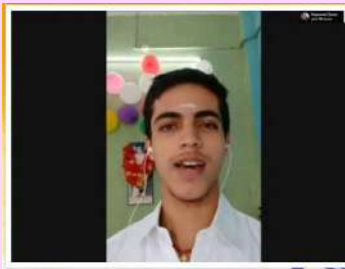

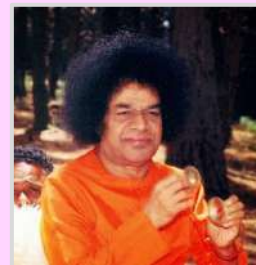
74TH INDEPENDENCE DAY

DEVOTIONSL SONGS OFFERING

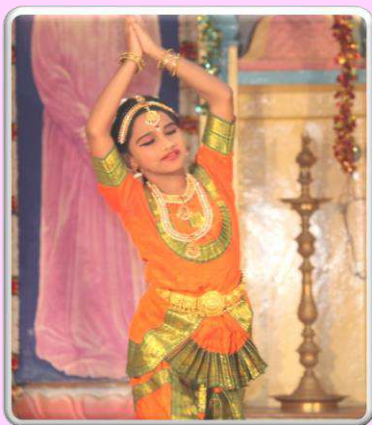

WEEKLY VALUE-BASED SATHSANGS FOR TEACHERS

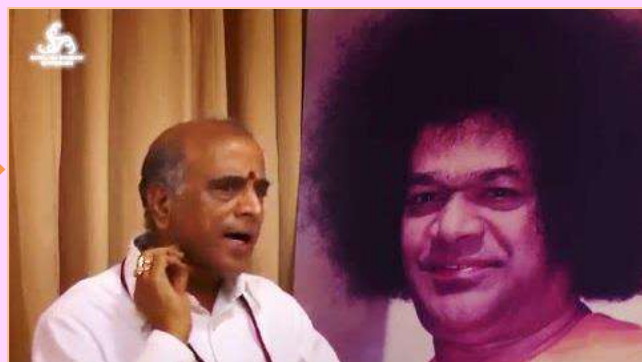

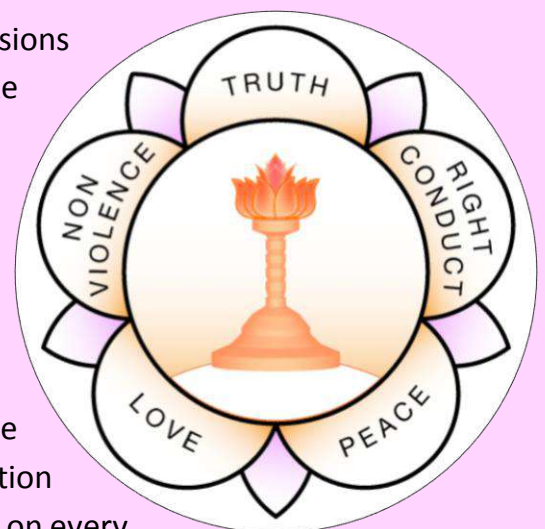

Apart from regular Balvikas class, Veda class, Sathsang sessions organized for the students to impart value-education and make them as ideal Sai students, to further intensify integrating values in academics and to follow the **SSSVV method of classes**, a special value education committee was formed with Correspondent, Principal and teachers who completed Diploma/Certificate course in Sri Sathya Sai Educare organized by the **Institute of Sathya Sai Education, Dharmakshetra, Mumabi**. Following His Divine instructions, SSSIE took initiative for the sound health of its Mahila staff by conducting yoga and pranayama classes for 5 weekends under the guidance of a dedicated **Yoga guru and health specialist Smt. INFRASTRUCTURE ACHIEVEMENTS



SSSIE NEW HOSTEL BUILDING

- Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Educare is a residential school providing Gurukula system of value-based integral education. Joining the hostel has been made compulsory for all boy students from VI to XII with an aim to mould character and promote overall personality development.
- The school classrooms were used as hostel dormitory before and after the school hours due to lack of a separate hostel building. The hostel strength also got increased due to the Senior Secondary classes (XI and XII).
- A true miracle before our eyes! With Divine Grace and sole support of the well-wishers of the school, the building construction that was started on 24th April 2018, got successfully completed during the Lockdown. In spite of the financial difficulties faced, this noble project aimed at providing better accommodation to the students, could be completed only through voluntary donations. It is ready for inauguration now.
